**Requirements**

Application must be filed by February 1 of the exemption year. No further filing is required as long as the property is maintained as a reservation. Livestock is not permitted upon the reserve, and the reserve cannot be used for economic gain other than the gain from raising fruit or forest trees. Property which has been exempt as a Forest or Fruit Tree Reservation may be subject to a recapture tax if the property ceases to qualify within five years after the last year that the exemption was granted. The application can only be accepted if it meets the criteria established by the Natural Resource Commission.
